New Club Lease Signed!

Get ready for a new field!

A lot of work has been going on in order to get a new field. We should all be grateful to all of the members working on trying to find a new field. President Mario Gonzales hit pay dirt (literally) when he contacted a land fill company in Kennedale. A private landfill company, C and D Landfill owned by IESI, has agreed to allow STRCC to use a portion of their land. This area is not too far from the old field location. "C and D Landfill" is located off Dick Price Road. They are a class 4 landfill which means that they are restricted in what kind of materials can accept. Most materials are construction excess or material from demolished structures.

IESI's property is approximately 26 acres. A portion of that land backs up to a creek and is designated as a flood plane. As a result of this, IESI can not use this section of land and is willing to lease it to STRCC for \$50 / year! With the location of the land, it looks like STRCC has found a good place to be. Hopefully this agreement and spot will last a long time.


STRCC officers met with the owner of C and D, Steve Orcutt, in January of this year. At that meeting, Steve showed us the land and was more than willing to help STRCC get a field in place.

IESI is allowing STRCC access to their property, but we have to remember that IESI is a company with equipment on site. We as members need to ensure that we do not leave gates unlocked and allow outsiders access to IESI's property and equipment. There will be a gate similar to that of the old field with two padlocks. One padlock will be for STRCC members and the other will be for IESI

employees. The locks will be interlocked allowing either party access to the property. STRCC members will have to lock the gate behind them when entering and leaving.

A lease agreement has been signed, AMA insurance paperwork, and a list of current STRCC members has been given to IESI. With that out of the way, a lock will be provided to lock up the entrance gate to the field. After that, STRCC officers will have to mark out the field and entrance to the field. These things should be in place by the next meeting scheduled on February 15th.

At the next meeting, there will be discussion on what STRCC should do for field preparation. We will definitely need membership help with the next phase of construction. Any ideas or recommendations would be greatly appreciated.


A summary of items/issues discussed are provided below.


